LEARNER-SOURCED


INDIVIDUAL CHARACTERISTICS



HUMILITY
Humility is linked to higher uncertainty tolerance as this trait allows room for alternative views.

MODERATOR - PURPLE


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COGNITIVE FLEXIBILITY
Learners who can think more laterally, and sift through information for relevancy.

MODERATOR - PURPLE


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SOCIAL COMPARISON
How others are considered in relation to self.

MODERATOR - ORANGE/PURPLE


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COGNITIVE INFLEXIBILITY
Learners steadfastly sticking to linear thinking.

MODERATOR - ORANGE


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CAPACITY FOR REFLECTION
Ability to consider one's responses across how they think, feel and act.

MODERATOR - PURPLE

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NEURODIVERGENCE, PERSONALITY, AND MENTAL HEALTH FACTORS
Traits and conditions influencing one's capacity to manage uncertainty.

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SUBJECT KNOWLEDGE



LOW SUBJECT PROFICIENCY
Learners with less discipline knowledge. These learners are typically early in their degree/year level.

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HIGH SUBJECT PROFICIENCY
Learners with more discipline knowledge. These learners are typically later in their degree/year level.

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LEARNING GOALS



MERIT-MINDED
Learners focused on extrinsic motivators (i.e. grades).

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SENSE OF PURPOSE
Learners who can think more laterally, and sift through information for relevancy. Learners who identify a purpose in their studies.

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WORLDVIEW



EVOLVING WORLDVIEW
Learners with a subjective worldview and a belief in contextual truths.

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OBJECTIVE WORLDVIEW
Learners with an objective worldview, and belief in singular truths.
